

TICKET INFORMATION

Our season begins in September and consists of six shows.

There are many ways to enjoy our performances: Season Tickets, Flex Passes, Individual Tickets and Gift Certificates.

PURCHASING INFORMATION

Individual tickets may be purchased ONLINE AT ANY TIME at GCPLAYHOUSE.ORG starting September 1 or through the Box Office (352-376-4949) starting September 9.

Our Box Office is open 10 days prior to opening night for each production. Tickets may be purchased in person or over the phone during our standard Box Office Hours of Wednesdays-Fridays, 12-6 p.m.

Gift certificates can be purchased in any amount at any time and do not expire - a perfect way to celebrate the holidays or birthdays.

SEASON TICKETS & FLEX PASSES

Purchase season tickets or flex passes and enjoy six shows for the price of five regularly-priced tickets. This is our way of saying thank you for your patronage of the Gainesville Community Playhouse. Additionally, both flex and regular season ticket holders enjoy the benefit of being able to exchange their tickets for different seats or dates if plans change.

SEASON TICKETS

This option guarantees you the same seat and performance day for every show. For example, you may wish to attend the opening night for each show of the season. Simply indicate your seating preferences, mail us the form with payment by August 17 and your tickets will be mailed to you by August 26.

FLEX PACKAGE

This option provides the same value as a season ticket but allows you both flexibility in choice of performance dates and the number of seats needed for each performance. When you choose this option, you will be issued a unique code that allows you to book online, at the box office, over the phone, or at the door, pending availability. If your plans change, you can exchange your seats, just like other subscribers.

You can order your flex passes by mail using the form provided or with the Box Office during our standard hours starting September 9, then use them at any time before they expire at the end of the 2026-27 season.
